



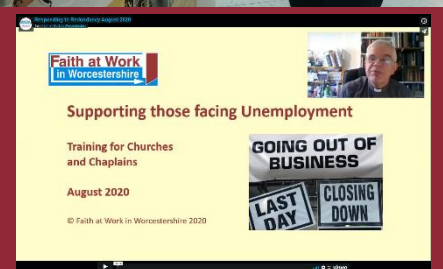
## What does workplace chaplaincy look like now?

Many Faith at Work in Worcestershire chaplains have returned to visiting, and been warmly welcomed. Those they meet have had much to share about their lockdown experience: delight at being able to return, and how, in many cases, business has quickly returned; anxiety about low turnover for some and whether they can keep going: exhaustion at the sheer hard work to keep things going during lockdown. One person spoke of panic attacks at being back in crowded places and how her company had been very supportive. Others of returning to find neighbours closed down, and a general sense of uncertainty about the future, and concern that all can stay safe.
