## EVENT REPORT from 1<sup>ST</sup> December 2020 Supporting those facing REDUNDANCY

Event organised by Faith at Work in Worcestershire, in collaboration with our neighbouring chaplaincy team Churches and Industry Group Birmingham & Solihull (CIBG) and the Jericho Foundation.







This Seminar, held in December, was convened in response to the major impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the economy, not least in the number of people losing their jobs and likely to lose their jobs in the coming months.

We considered:

1. Where are we likely to meet people facing redundancy?

2. Having a simple conversation about redundancy and the experience of being unemployed.

3. A Toolkit for anyone offering one-to-one support including helping people deal with the trauma of losing a job, signposting to sources of help, retraining, practical steps back to work, CV writing and jobsearching.

4. Reaching out to help as part of our Christian calling.

We had 34 people attend from our own team, FWW and CIGB and also from other neighbouring teams in the Blackcountry (BCUIM) and from Coventry & Warwickshire (Workcare). The feedback was overwhelmingly positive, including this from Angela Gerrard from the Pershore Churches Together Chaplaincy Team, "I think the seminar was well-balanced as a whole and acknowledged the very different settings we find ourselves in, with plenty of information given from which we might select information, signposts or places for people to access themselves."

Another of our chaplains raised a very interesting and worthwhile point about ensuring that jobs were created which promote a "greener and fairer" world. A further comment was, "It opened my understanding to the present situation. I got a lot out of it."
